Compulsory coach education





What is it?

NWSF association coaches must complete a coach education qualification:

Age group	Qualification required	Previous equivalent
U6 to U8s	Miniroos Certificate	Miniroos Certificate
U9 to U12s	Foundations of Football	Skill Training Certificate
U13 to U18s Division 1 and 2	Foundations of Football	Game Training Certificate
Super League and Premier League	Foundations of Football OR C Diploma	Senior Certificate

• This applies to male, mixed and female team coaches

Note

- In 2024, the coaching pathway and coach education registration system has changed
- Previous certificates included the Skill Training, Game Training and Senior Certificate. These have now become the one course - the Foundations of Football
 - o The Foundations of Football is now a prerequisite to enrolling in a C Diploma
- Coaches who completed Skill Training, Game Training or Senior Certificate in the past 3 years will be transferred to now hold the Foundations of Football qualification
 - Note all courses have a 3 year expiry date from the date of completion

Why compulsory coach education?

- To increase the quality of our player's football experience, as this is the number one reason why people choose to stay/leave our game
- To increase the quality of our coaching, as this is the core driver for the football experience
- To increase the quality of development of our people and players
- To increase the enjoyment levels and longevity of coaches
- To decrease the need for time spent on getting coaches to coaching courses from clubs
- To engage high level young players in our Premier League and Super League competitions

What do DOCs do?

- Allocate the coach to a team by the start of preseason
- Check which coaches have completed qualifications as per above. A reminder that coaches who
 have completed previous qualifications in the last 3 years are now recognised as having a
 Foundations of Football
- If they are not qualified, get them to book into one of the below courses. All are free to the participant. The club and association will cover the course costs but please be aware there is an expectation you will coach or manage one of the clubs teams.
- When putting in your team registrations, ensure the coach is registered as the team coach

What happens if clubs are not qualified?

- Remember this is not a "tick the box" process, but is so you can ensure your players and parents
 will have a positive experience at your club. The compulsory criteria is to make this expectation
 easier for clubs and coaches.
- We intend to recognise through social media and our website clubs with full compliance

What do coaches do?

- Check your coaching qualification by going to FA's new coach education system, https://learn.footballaustralia.com.au/
- If your qualification is not complete, not valid for your 2024 age group, or out of date (all
 qualifications are valid for 3 years) then enrol in available courses at
 https://learn.footballaustralia.com.au/, using your PlayFootball login.
 - All courses are free. NWSF coaches will receive a discount code to take 100% off the advertised price, to be used at registration.
 - This code is for the exclusive use of NWSF coaches only.
